We aim to make our setting accessible to children and families from all sections of the local community.

We aim to advertise our services widely and reflect the diversity of our society in our publicity and promotional materials. We will provide information in clear, concise language, whether in spoken or written form, and in as many languages as possible.

We arrange our waiting list in birth order. In addition we may take into account siblings already attending the setting.

We keep a place vacant, if this is financially viable, to accommodate an emergency admission.

Our setting welcomes both fathers and mothers and other relations and carers, including childminders.

We monitor the gender and ethnic background of children joining the group to ensure that our intake is representative of social diversity. All parents are given written information about the pre-school, including our Equal Opportunities Policy

We are flexible about attendance patterns to accommodate the needs of individual children and families, providing these do not disrupt the pattern of continuity in the setting that provides stability for all the children.
